3. Personal Statement
4. Reference Letters or Letters of Commendation
5. Copy of Acceptance Letter from the College or University you are going to attend

Applications will be evaluated as follows:

- Academic Readiness (GPA) 30 points
- Application Packet 20 points
- Personal Statement Essay 20 points
- Grammar/ neatness/ presentation/ response to topic 10 points
- School and Community Service..... 10 points
- Letters of Recommendation.....10 points



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RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

1. The Eta Epsilon Omega Chapter reserves the right to suspend, change or terminate this program at any time.
2. The interpretation, application and administration of this program shall be determined solely by the Eta Epsilon Omega Chapter Scholarship Committee and all decisions made by Eta Epsilon Omega Chapter shall be final.
3. Scholarships are not transferable to any other persons and are for the sole and exclusive use and benefit of the scholarship awardees only.
4. The scholarship recipient shall immediately notify the Eta Epsilon Omega Chapter Scholarship Committee, upon the occurrence of the following events:
 - a. The student becomes ineligible due to failing grades, drop outs, failure to matriculate, suspension or withdrawal
5. Scholarship award decisions are based on the candidates' grade point averages, references, recommendations from teachers or counselors, commendations received, level of involvement in school and community activities. Applicants must possess academic ranking of B or better.
6. Scholarship awards must be claimed and/or utilized by recipients within one year of the award.
7. *Incomplete applications or those which are received after the deadline will not be considered.*
